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NOTICE INVITING TENDER

1. Sealed tenders are invited by the **Chief Engineer, Department of Hydro Power Development, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Itanagar** on behalf of the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh for the work “**C/o Angong SHP in Upper Siang District of Arunachal Pradesh (SH : Supplying, erection, testing and successful commissioning of 3 X 1500 KW sets complete on lump sum turnkey basis i/c associated Switchyard)**”
 - 1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 972.00 Lakhs (Rupees Nine Hundred Seventy Two Lakhs) only.**
 - 1.2 Reputed manufacturers of Hydro Turbine Generating Sets or their authorized licensee or their authorized dealer or EPC Contractors of repute Registered in India having experience of executing similar works i.e., designing, manufacturing, testing, supplying, erection and commissioning of Francis type Hydro generating sets of 1.0 MW and above on turnkey basis and who fulfill all of the following requirements shall be eligible to apply for issue of tender papers (non-transferable) provided, they produce definite proof from the appropriate authority which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority of the Department. Joint Ventures between EPC Contractor and manufacturers of Hydro Turbine Generating Sets, as described above, are also allowed subject to fulfillment of other conditions by individual JV Partner as stipulated in the NIT.
 - (a) Should have satisfactorily completed or on the verge of completion three similar works of similar capacity as enumerated above each costing not less than **Rs. 389.00 Lakhs** or two similar works each costing not less than **Rs. 486.00 Lakhs** or one similar work costing not less than **Rs. 778.00 Lakhs** during the last seven years ending last day of the month of March, 2007. **This should be certified by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer / Project Manager or equivalent for each work.**
 - (b) Should have had average annual financial turnover of **Rs. 292.00 Lakhs** during last three years ending 31st March, 2007. This should be duly audited by a Chartered Accountant. Year in which no turnover is shown would also be considered for working out the average.
 - (c) Should not have incurred any loss in more than two years during the last five years ending 31st March, 2006 duly certified by the Chartered Accountant.
 - (d) Should have a solvency of **Rs. 389.00 Lakhs** certified by its Bankers.
 - (e) The applicant should have sufficient number of Technical / Managerial and Administrative employees for the proper execution of the Contract and should submit a list of these employees stating clearly how these would be involved in work.
 - (f) In case of authorized licensees / dealers / firms / contractors, guarantee for prompt service back up as regards to providing of spares and after sales service from the manufacturers of turbine and generators shall also be provided and undertaking to this effect shall be provided on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- at the time of applying for Bid documents.
 - (g) **In case of imported machineries (Turbine and Generating Sets) the manufacturer either themselves or through their licensee or dealer must have well equipped infrastructure with sufficient technically competent manpower in India to provide prompt after sale service as regards to providing of spares and repairing. Undertaking to this effect on non-judicial Stamp paper of Rs. 100/- alongwith documentary evidence to this effect must also be provided by the Bidder at the time of applying for Bid document. However, considering the easy accessibility and service availability, indigenous make would be preferred.**

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- 1.3 The intending bidders while applying for issue of tender papers should submit the above informations regarding fulfilling of eligibility criteria in prescribed forms viz. Form 'A', 'B' & 'C' for 1.2 (a), Form 'D' for 1.2 (b), (c) & (d), Form 'E' & 'E1' for 1.2 (e).
- 1.4 Bidding document will be issued to the prima-facie qualified bidders. However, such issuance of bidding document will not automatically mean that such a bidder is considered qualified. The details furnished by the bidder alongwith the bid will be examined in detail as per the requirement of the bidding documents and his eligibility will be established accordingly.
- 1.5 The eligibility criteria and complete bidding documents are available on the website www.arunachalpradesh.nic.in. Interested bidders can down load the bidding documents to commence preparation of bids **to gain time**. However, they will be required to purchase pre-authenticated copy of the documents from the office of the Chief Engineer, Department of Hydro Power Development, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Itanagar. **Addendum / Corrigendum / extension (if any) pertaining to this tender will be published in above website only. For this Bidders are requested to visit the website regularly till the opening of this N.I.T. In case of any discrepancy between the documents down loaded by the prospective bidder (s) and the documents issued by the Department, the later shall prevail.**
- 1.6 Even though an applicant may satisfy the above requirements, he would be liable to disqualification even at a later stage leading to unilateral termination of the agreement by the Department of and the Security Deposit / Earnest Money of the contractor shall be forfeited if he has.
- (a) made **misleading or false representation or deliberately suppressed the information** in the forms / statements and enclosures.
- (b) record of poor performance such as abandoning work, not properly completing the contract, or financial / failures / weakness etc.
- The department reserves the right to verify the particulars furnished by the intending bidders independently.
- 1.7 The tender shall be submitted in 2 (two) bids namely; Technical Bid and Price Bid. Each of the Bids shall be placed and sealed in separate cover.
- 1.8 Envelopes containing technical bid shall be opened first to assess the technical viability of their proposals. Price bid of only those bidders shall be opened who qualify the technical bid.
2. Agreement shall be drawn with successful tenderer on prescribed Form No. CPWD 12 which is available as a Govt. of India Publication. Tenderer shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form including any additional terms and conditions of the Department, which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **300 days** to be reckoned from the date of issue of L.O.I / letter of award.
4. The site for the work i.e. Angong SHP is located at Janbo in Upper Siang District in Arunachal Pradesh.
5. The tenderer shall prepare the Bids after visiting the site of work and should have satisfied himself as to the nature and character of work to be executed and also of the site condition and other relevant matters and details for which they have to contact the field officers of the Geku Division of Department of Hydro Power Development, i.e. Executive Engineer (C), Geku Division, DHPD, Upper Siang District, Geku, (A.P.).
6. Receipt of applications for issue of forms will be stopped by 1600 Hrs, **7 days** before the date fixed for opening of tenders. Issue of tender forms will be stopped **1 day** before the date fixed for opening of tenders.

The tender paper can be collected by the eligible intender fulfilling the conditions as laid down at Sl. No. 1.2 from the office of the **Chief Engineer, Department of Hydro Power Development, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Itanagar** on any working days between 1000 Hrs. to 1600 Hrs. on payment of **Rs. 1,500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred)** only in cash or Demand Draft in favour of **the Chief Engineer, Department of Hydro Power Development, Itanagar**.

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7. The tenderer must produce an Income –Tax clearance certificate in the revised form as modified under Ministry of finance O.M. No. 67/30/69/ITAL dated 02-07-1970 as amended from time to time at the time of submission of the tender papers and shall form a part of technical bid.
8. Tenders which should always be placed in sealed envelope, with the name of work and due date written on the envelopes, will be received by the **Chief Engineer, Department of Hydro Power Development, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Itanagar** up to 2.30 P.M. on **05/06/2007** and will be opened by him or his authorized representative in his office on the same day at 03.00 P.M.
- 8.1 The tender shall be accompanied by earnest money of **Rs. 19.44 Lakhs** which should be deposited in the form of Call Deposit Receipt of any Nationalised Bank, Bank Draft payable at **State Bank of India, Yingkiong (A.P.)** / Bank Guarantee of any Scheduled Nationalised Bank in favour of **Executive Engineer (C), Geku Division, DHPD, Upper Siang District, Geku, (A.P.)** The Fixed Deposit Receipt shall be accepted only if it is valid for six months or more after the last date of receipt of tenders and is pledged in favour of **Executive Engineer (C), Geku Division, DHPD, Upper Siang District, Geku, (A.P.)**.
- 8.2. The tender and the earnest money shall be placed in separate sealed envelopes and super scribed **“TENDER”**, and **“EARNEST MONEY”** respectively. Both the envelopes shall be submitted together in another sealed envelope. The envelope marked **“TENDER”** (which in turn shall be containing technical & price bids in separate sealed covers each super scribed **“TECHNICAL BID”** & **“PRICE BID”** respectively) of only those tenderers shall be opened, whose earnest money placed in the other envelope is found to be in order. Tenderers will write the name of their firms, name of work and date of opening on each cover.
9. The description of the work is as follows.

“C/o Angong SHP in Upper Siang District of Arunachal Pradesh (SH : Supplying, erection, testing and commissioning of 3 X 1500 KW sets i/c associated Switchyard complete on lump sum turnkey basis)”

Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site of works whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools, & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools, and plant etc. will be issued to him by the Department of Hydro Power Development and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on execution of the work.
10. The competent authority on behalf of Governor of Arunachal Pradesh does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any other tender, and reserves to himself the right authority to reject any or all of the tenders received without the assigning of a reason. All tenders, in which any of the prescribed conditions is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer, shall be liable to be summarily rejected.
11. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contactors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
12. The competent authority on behalf of Governor of Arunachal Pradesh reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
13. The contractor shall not be permitted to tender for the work in the Department of Hydro Power Development (responsible for award and execution of contracts) in which his near relative is posted as Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Department of Hydro Power Development or in the Ministry of Power, Arunachal Pradesh. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would result in rejection of his tender for the said work of this Department even at a later stage as and when detected.

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14. No Engineer of gazetted rank or other Gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of Arunachal Pradesh is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of two years after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of Arunachal Pradesh in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of Arunachal Pradesh as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractors service.
15. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **180 (One Hundred Eighty)** days from the date of opening of tenders. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the said period or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the Department of Hydro Power Development, then this department shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit the earnest money as aforesaid.
16. This notice inviting tender shall form a part of the contract document. The successful tenderer /contractor, on acceptance of his tender by the Accepting Authority, shall, within 7 days from the stipulated date of start of the work sign the contract consisting of :-
 - a). The notice inviting tender, all relevant documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming the tender as issued at the time of invitation of tender and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.
 - b). Standard C. P.W.D. Form 12.
17. Rates quoted shall inclusive of all taxes, duties and levies etc. and nothing extra shall be allowed over the quoted price during the entire period of execution.
18. In case of any dispute, as regards to interpretation of the Clauses of the NIT and tender, the decision of the department shall final and binding on the Bidder / Contractor.
