NOTIFICATION

The 14th December, 2016

(Under Section (10) of Balipara/Tirap/Sadiya, Frontier Tract Jhum Land Regulation, 1947)

No. LM-07/2016.—**WHEREAS**, the power to acquire land is vested with the Government of Arunachal Pradesh and it is the competence of the Governor to notify any land within the state of Arunachal Pradesh for public purpose under section (10) of Jhum Land Regulation, 1947.

AND WHEREAS, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is satisfied that the land mentioned in the schedule below is needed for public purpose namely for setting up of Power Sub-Stations under the jurisdiction of Deputy Commissioner, Tirap District, Khonsa.

AND WHEREAS, Deputy Commissioner, Tirap District, Khonsa shall prepare the compensation estimate as per the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

AND WHEREAS, adequate compensation will be paid as per the provision of section 26 of LARR' Act, 2013.

AND THEREFORE, The Deputy Commissioner Tirap District, Khonsa is hereby directed to take possession of the above notified land subject to NOC from the Department of **ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS**.

Any person who has any objection to the acquisition of said land for the said purpose may file such objection in writing to the office of the Deputy Commissioner/DLR&SO Tirap District, Khonsa within **30 (thirty)** days from the publication of this Notification by clearly stating the reason for such objection. The Deputy Commissioner in their capacity shall dispose off the same after giving reasonable opportunity of hearing to extinguish the claim of the land owners.
