II).— In pursuance of Government of India's order No. F-2301/1/2007-BC-II dated 19th February, 2008, regarding constitution of State/District Level Monitoring Committee to enforce Cable Television Networks (Regulation) Act, 1995, the Government of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to constitute following as members of the State Level Monitoring Committee.

1. Secretary, Information and Public Relations : Chairman
2. Representative of DGP : Member
3. Secretary, Social Welfare : Member
4. Smti Oter Ering Tayeng, Arunachal Pradesh Women Welfare Society : Member
5. Dr. Nani Bath, Professor, Rajiv Gandhi University Doimukh (Academician) : Member
6. Director of Information & Public Relations : Member-Secretary

The Committee shall have a term of two years. It shall meet at least once a year and submit detailed annual report for the State including district-wise data of all cable operators registered within the state and forward report to the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Government of India before 31st December, each year.

The functions of this State Level Monitoring Committee will be as follows :

- (i) To see whether District/Local committees have been formed and whether the concerned committees have been meeting regularly.
- (ii) To see whether the authorized officers are effectively performing their duties.
- (iii) To see how many cases are handled by them and what decisions are arrived at.
- (iv) To give suggestions/guidance to District/Local Level Committee and to take required decisions matters referred by District Level/Local Committees.
- (v) To collect date/information from District/Local Level Committees and forward them to Secretary, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Government of India, and,
- (vi) To recommend action and forward complaints against satellite channels (national channels) to the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Government of India, in cases of violation of Government of India's orders on the Programme and Advertising Codes.
