NOTIFICATION

The 20th November, 2017

(Under Section (10) of Balipara/Tirap/Sadiya, Frontier Tract Jhum Land Regulation, 1947)

No. LM-37/2010 (Pt).—**WHEREAS**, the power to acquire land is vested in the Government of Arunachal Pradesh and it is the competence of the Government to notify any land within the state of Arunachal Pradesh for public purpose under Section (10) of Jhum Land Regulation Act, 1947.

AND WHEREAS, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is satisfied that the land mentioned in the schedule below is needed for the public purpose namely for establishment of BoP SSB falling under jurisdiction of Deputy Commissioner, West Kameng District, Bomdila.

AND WHEREAS, compensation will be paid as per provision of Section 26 of LARR Act, 2013.

AND NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Arunachal Pradesh do hereby declare that the land described in the schedule below is hereby notified for the above mentioned purpose under Section (10) of Balipara/Tirap/Sadiya, Frontier Tract Jhum Land Regulation, 1947.

AND THEREFORE, the Deputy Commissioner, West Kameng District, Bomdila is hereby directed to take possession of the above land.

Any person who has any objection to the acquisition of said land for the said purpose may file such objection in writing to the office of the Deputy Commissioner, West Kameng District, Bomdila within 30 (thirty) days from the publication of this notification by clearly stating the reason for such objection and the Deputy Commissioner, in their capacity shall dispose off the same after giving reasonable opportunity of hearing to extinguish the claim of land owners.
