THE ARUNACHAL PRADESH SPEAKER AND DEPUTY SPEAKER SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2017.

(ACT NO. 4 OF 2018)

further to amend the Arunachal Pradesh Speaker and Deputy Speaker Salaries and Allowances Act, 1983 (No. 7 of 1983).

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Arunachal Pradesh in the Sixty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows :

- (1) This Act may be called the Arunachal Pradesh Speaker and Deputy Speaker Salaries and Allowances (Amendment) Act, 2017. Short title and commencement.
- (2) It shall come into force at once.
- In the Arunachal Pradesh Speaker and Deputy Speaker Salaries and Allowances Act, 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act), for Section 3, Substitution of Section 3.
the following section shall be substituted namely :-
“3. On and from the date of the Arunachal Pradesh Speaker and Deputy Speaker Salaries and Allowances (Amendment) Act, 2017 comes into force, there shall be paid to the Speaker a composite salary of Rupees One Lakh Twenty Eight Thousand per mensem and to the Deputy Speaker a composite salary of Rupees One Lakh Twenty Four Thousand per mensem.
Provided further that, the other perks, facilities, incentives and non-quantifiable allowances which are not specified in this Act shall be regulated by an executive order as per actual or at such rate with ceiling limit as the State Government may determine from time to time as may be deemed appropriate.”
- In the Principal Act, Sections 4, 6, 7, 9 and 10 shall be deleted. Deletion of Sections 4, 6, 7, 9 and 10.
