No. HMB (B)37/97 Pt.-D.—In partial modification of earlier Government Notification No. HMB(B) 37/97 dated 24th January, 2012 and in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 357A of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act No. 2 of 1974), the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to amend the **Schedule - I to the Arunachal Pradesh Victim Compensation Scheme, 2011** by enhancing the existing amounts of compensation provided under the said Scheme and by incorporating certain other loss or injury not covered under the existing said Scheme so as to conform to the requirements of Central Victim Compensation Fund Scheme as shown under :

SCHEDULE - I

(to the Arunachal Pradesh Victim Compensation Scheme, 2011)

Sl. No.	Particular of loss or injury	Existing maximum limit of Compensation amount	Enhanced maximum limit of Compensation amount
1.	Loss of life/death (families of victims of unnatural death in prison, police custody and judicial custody are also eligible for compensation).	₹ 2,00,000	₹ 3,00,000
2.	(a) Rape	₹ 50,000	₹ 5,00,000
	(b) Rape and death	—	₹ 7,00,000
3.	Acid Attack	₹ 1,00,000	₹ 3,00,000
4.	Permanent disability (80% or more)	₹ 50,000	₹ 2,00,000
5.	Partial disability (40% to less than 80%)	₹ 20,000	₹ 1,00,000
6.	Loss of any limb or part of body resulting in below 40% disability.	₹ 10,000	₹ 50,000
7.	Loss or injury causing severe mental agony to women and child victims in cases like human trafficking etc.	₹ 10,000	₹ 50,000
8.	Simple loss or injury to child victim	₹ 10,000	₹ 50,000
9.	Rehabilitation of victim of human trafficking.	₹ 20,000	₹ 1,00,000
10.	Physical abuse of minor	—	₹ 2,00,000
11.	Sexual assault (excluding rape)	—	₹ 50,000
12.	Burns affecting greater than 25% of the body (excluding acid attack cases)	—	₹ 2,00,000
13.	Loss of foetus due to physical abuse	—	₹ 50,000

N.B : If the victim is less than 14 years of age, the compensation shall be increased by 50% over the amounts specified above.
