No. SJETA/20/2018/MoTA/ALC.—The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to constitute an Apex Level Committee (ALC), Executive Committee and District Level Committees consisting of the following members to formulate policies relating to implementing of Programmes and activities under proviso to Article 275 (1) of the Constitution of India/Tribal Sub Plan (TSP), in the State of Arunachal Pradesh, as per the Guidelines for Inter-state Allocation of funds issued by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.

1. APEX LEVEL COMMITTEE (ALC) :

1.	Chief Minister, Arunachal Pradesh	Chairman
2.	Minister-in-charge of Tribal Welfare	Member
3.	Chief Secretary	Member
4.	Commissioner (SJETA)	Member
5.	Secretary (Planning)	Member

2. FUNCTION OF APEX LEVEL COMMITTEE (ALC) :

- To formulate policies relating to Schemes/Programmes under 1st proviso to article 275 (1) of the constitution of India/Tribal Sub Plan (TSP).
- To approve Perspective Annual Plan Documents under Proviso to Article 275 (1) of the Constitution and Tribal Sub Plan (TSP).
- To suggest measures for proper Planning and Implementation of Schemes by different Departments.
- To monitor progress of schemes under Article 275 (1)/Tribal Sub Plan (TSP). The Apex Level Committee (ALC), will meet once in six months. The Department of Tribal Affairs shall provide necessary Secretarial back up to ALC.

II. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE (EC) :

2.	Principal Secretary/Secretary-in-charge of all the line Departments.	Members
3.	Principal Secretary/Secretary-in-charge of Nodal Departments.	Member Secretary

KEY FUNCTIONS OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE (EC) :

- Appraisal of Perspective Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) documents and finalization of Programmes/Schemes under Article 275 (1) of the constitution of India.
- Monitoring and evaluation implementation of the annual Tribal Sub Plan (TSP)/Programmes under Article 275(1) of the constitution of India.
- Formulation of Strategy for tackling development Deficit of ST. The Executive Committee will hold its meetings once every three months.

III. DISTRICT PLANNING AND MONITORING COMMITTEE (DPMC) :

1.	Deputy Commissioner	Chairman
2.	Project officer of ITDP/ITDA District Tribal Welfare Officer	Secretary
3.	District Level Officers of concerned Line Departments.	Member

The District Planning and Monitoring Committee (DPMC) may also have representation from local Legislative and Parliamentary Constituencies.

KEY FUNCTIONS OF DISTRICT PLANNING AND MONITORING COMMITTEE (DPMC) :

- (a) Formulate Plan at the District Level.
- (b) Get it approved by the District Planning Committee.
- (c) Review implementation of Programmes/Activities under Article 275(1) Grant/Tribal Sub Plan (TSP).
- (d) Communicate quarterly Performance Review Report to Nodal Department for review by it and the Executive Committee.
