## ORDER

The 2nd November, 2018

No. PERS-56/93(Pt-II)/310.—**Whereas**, vide Government Order No. PERS-56/93(Pt-II)/422 dated 13th February, 2018, Shri Mirpe Tato, APCS (Senior Grade), EAC, Office of the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Mechuka, West Siang District was placed under suspension with immediate effect in connection with issuance of 152 numbers of fake Arms License while he was holding the additional charge of ADC, Nyapin in Kurung Kumey District. The said Arms license were issued by the officer with back dates from 26th March, 2016 to 28th March, 2016 violating the blanket ban imposed on issue of Arms License imposed by the Government vide Order No. PSH-6/2012-13/198 dated 23rd August, 2013 and dated 2nd September, 2016 respectively ;

**And Whereas**, subsequently on the recommendation of the Suspension Review Committee held on 11th May, 2018, the term of suspension period of Shri Mirpe Tato, APCS (Senior Grade) (under suspension) was extended for a further period of 180 days with effect from 13th May, 2018 to 8th November, 2018 ;

**And whereas**, due to his involvement in an another vigilance case bearing No. SIC(VIG)PS C/No.01/2007 U/s 120 (B)/468/471 IPC R/W Sec. 13 (2) & (3) (1) (d) of PC Act, 1988 and on receipt of an application from Shri R. Monpa, Deputy Superintendent of Police, SIC (VIG) Police Station, Itanagar, who is the investigation officer of the above Vigilance case, the Competent Authority has issued "Prosecution Sanction Order" against the aforesaid Officer vide order dated 25th January, 2018 ;

**And whereas**, the meeting of the Suspension Review Committee was held on 2nd November, 2018 in this regard. After detailed deliberations and taking into consideration all the facts and circumstances of the case, the serious charges leveled against the said officer who was indulged in gross misconduct and has acted in total violation of prescribed Government Orders and the fact that criminal proceedings have also been initiated against him, the Suspension Review Committee decided that the suspension of Shri Mirpe Tato, APCS (Sr.Grd), EAC, Mechuka be extended for another 6 (six) months with effect from 9th November, 2018 ;

**And whereas**, the competent Authority after due examination of all the facts and circumstances of the cases and documents placed on record has accepted the aforesaid recommendation of the Suspension Review Committee ;

**Now therefore**, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, in exercise of powers conferred by the Rule 10(6) of the CCS (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1965, hereby extends the Suspension of said Shri Mirpe Tato, APCS (Senior Grade) for a further period of 180 days with effect from 9th November, 2018 to 7th May, 2019.

It is further ordered that during the period that this order shall remain in force, the headquarters of Shri Mirpe Tato, APCS (Senior Grade) shall be Mechuka in West Siang District and he shall not leave the headquarters without obtaining the previous permission of the undersigned.
