Subject :- **Discontinuance of Family Planning Allowance for adoption of small Family norms-recommendation of the 7th Central Pay Commission.**

F. No. 12(4)/2016-E/III.A.—The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's OM No. 7(20)/2008-E-III A dated 24th September, 2008 regarding the existing rates of Family Planning Allowance (FPA) admissible to Central Government employees and to say that as provided for in para 7 of this Ministry's Resolution No. 1-2/2016-IC dated 25th July, 2016, the matter regarding allowances (except Dearness Allowance) based on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission was referred to a Committee under the Chairmanship of Finance Secretary and until a final decision thereon, all allowances were required to be paid at the existing rates in the existing pay structure (the pay structure based on 6th Pay Commission) as if the pay has not been revised with effect from 1st January, 2016. Accordingly, FPA was also required to be paid at the existing rates specified in the aforesaid OM dated 24th September, 2008.

2. The decisions of the Government on various allowances based on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission and in the light of the recommendations of the Committee under the Chairmanship of the Finance Secretary have since been notified as per the Resolution No. 11-1/2016-IC dated 6th July, 2017.

3. As mentioned at Sl. No. 60 of the Appendix-II of the said Resolution dated 6th July, 2017, the recommendation of the 7th Central Pay Commission to abolish Family Planning Allowance has been accepted and this decision is effective from 1st July, 2017. Accordingly, FPA Family Planning Allowance, as admissible hitherto, shall cease to exist in all cases.

4. These orders shall take effect from 1st July, 2017 and hence Family Planning Allowance shall stand discontinued with effect from 1st July, 2017.

5. In their application to the employees serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, these orders are issued in consultation with the Office of C&AG.

No. WCD-23/2015-16-Creche/4946-5096.—In pursuance to the decision conveyed by the Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Women and Child Development through its D.O. letter No. CRE-12/14/2016-Creche dated 17th February, 2017 for taking over the Creche Centres under Rajiv Gandhi National Creche Scheme from the existing implementing agencies i.e., Central Social Welfare Board (CSWB) and Indian Council for Child Welfare (ICCW), the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to take over the functional Creches in the State of Arunachal Pradesh under the control and administration of the Women and Child Development Department currently being run by Arunachal Pradesh State Social Welfare Board through various Non-Governmental Organizations and Indian Council for Child Welfare, Arunachal Pradesh Unit on **"As is where is basis"** with effect from 15th September, 2017 (A/N).

The location of Creches alongwith name of NGOs running the Creches are enclosed at Annexure-I.

Administrative and fund flow mechanism on taking over the Creches :-

* The Deputy Directors (ICDS) of the respective districts shall be the Nodal Officer at the district level responsible for taking over the Creches from the NGOs after proper verification and they shall submit a consolidated report to the Director, Women and Child Development Department. They shall so be directly responsible for management and administer the Creches under their respective jurisdiction.

- * All the movable and immovable properties, viz; buildings, furniture etc, created / purchased from Government sources shall come under the disposal of concerned department from the day of taking over the Creche Centres.
- * The existing NGOs shall be responsible to run the Creches till an alternative mechanism is developed by the concerned department after examining the status of functioning of the Creches, if necessary.
- * All the functionaries now employed in the Creches shall continue to function as earlier for the smooth running of the Creches and other service condition shall be governed as per rules and regulation of the NGOs. The Salary/Honorarium etc, of the Creche Workers and Helpers shall be applicable as per the schematic norms as prescribed by the Government of India under Rajiv Gandhi National Creche Scheme.
- * Nodal Officers shall ensure that the implementing agencies have been following the guidelines of the Rajiv Gandhi National Creche Scheme for the children circulated by the Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India, New Delhi in all respect.
- * The NGOs running the Creches shall submit their financial estimates to the Director, Women and Child Development Department, Government of Arunachal Pradesh, Naharlagun through their respective Deputy Director (ICDS).
- * Total financial involvement shall be worked out and submitted to the Central/State Government for release of fund for financing the scheme as per the CSS funding pattern.
- * The fund release to the NGOs shall be through Public Financial Management System (PFMS)-Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) platform. The channel of flow of fund shall be decided in due course.

No. 280434-II/64/2017.—It has come to the notice of the Government that lot of delay occurs in conduct of Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) meeting by many departments affecting the benefit of promotion/MACP scheme/Confirmation of services of the employees working under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh in spite of existence of time line and calendar. In this connection the Government of Arunachal Pradesh had issued following Office Memorandums for ensuring timely and regular conduct or Departmental Promotion Committee meeting:

1. Office Memorandum No. AR-101/2015/3150 dated 7th August, 2015 enclosing model calendar for holding DPC along with guidelines for advance convening of DPC.
2. Office Memorandum No. AR-54/2016 dated 16th June, 2016 enclosing a check list for convening the DPC such as RRs, Seniority list, Eligibility list, Note for DPC, DPC Performa, ACRs (APARs), Vigilance Clearance, Integrity certificate, Penalties, Miscellaneous, completion certificate.

2. The delay in conduct of DPC negates the purpose of Model calendar, impedes the career progression of the employees. The meeting of DPC are usually not convened in time due to non-availability of documents as mentioned at serial No. 2 above wherein it has already directed to the Departments for necessity of timely preparation of documents and also for keeping all documents ready.

3. The delay in conduct of DPC also invites large number of unwanted litigation leading to untold hardship to the employees due to lethargic and irresponsible approach of the Appointing Authorities. No. AR-68/2010.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 46 of the State of Arunachal Pradesh Act, 1986 (Act No. 69 of 1986), the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to order adaptation of F.R. - 56 (a) and (b) notified vide GoI Notifications No. 25012/2/97-Estt (A) dated 13th May, 1998, dated 27th May, 1998 and dated 8th December, 1998 with effect from 1st January, 2018 in respect of Group "A", "B" and "C" State Government servants other than Doctors under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, with necessary modification which shall read as follows:-

"F.R. 56 (a) Except as otherwise provided in these rules, every Government servant shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the month in which he attains the age of sixty years;

Provided that a Government servant whose date of birth is the first of a month shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the preceding month on attaining the age of sixty years ;

Provided further that a Government servant, who has attained the age of fifty-eight years on or before 1st day of January, 2018 and is on extension in service, shall retire from the service on expiry of his/her extended period of service or on the expiry of any further extension in service granted by the State Government in public interest, provided that, no such extension in service shall be granted beyond the age of sixty (60) years.

(b) A work man who is governed by these rules shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the month in which he attains the age of sixty (60) years."

This modifies the Government Notification No. FIN/E/47/87 (Pt) dated 16th February, 1989 and No. FIN/E-II-47/94 dated 6th January, 1999 with respect to Clause 2 (1) 1 relating to FR-56 of the FRSR.
