(a) Death case per victim (to NoK)	—	₹ 4,00,000
(b) Critically injured	—	₹ 2,00,000
(c) Injured	—	₹ 50,000

3. As regards definition of grievous & minor injuries, medical terminology used by Medical officers shall be followed. The payment of ex-gratia is delinked from MACT awards.

4. Further, financial assistance on urgent medical treatment shall be provided to the needy and poor people who have not been covered under Chief Minister's Universal Health Insurance Scheme (CMUHIS). Maximum financial assistance shall not exceed ₹ 4,00,000 (Rupees four lakh) only in each case. Patients with terminal diseases/ critically ill patients, even if they are covered under CMUHIS shall also be entitled up to this prescribed ceiling. Financial assistance for medical treatment shall be provided for major treatment and for critical diseases only.

5. The Department of Disaster Management shall project annual requirement of fund for Chief Minister's Relief Fund in the Budget Estimate.

6. The required fund for Chief Minister's Relief Fund shall be allocated to the Department of Disaster Management and in turn the Department shall draw the fund from the Treasury and deposit the same to CMRF.

7. The financial assistance received from the Corporate Social Responsibility Sector and other sources shall be properly accounted into CMRF and the fund shall be utilized judiciously.

8. The Chief Minister's Secretariat shall handle the CMRF as usual and disburse the ex-gratia payment and other financial assistance directly to the NoK or the beneficiaries through Cheque after proper verification and scrutiny of each case.

9. Henceforth, no ex-gratia payment shall be done from the Home and District Administration Departments.

10. The notification shall come into force with effect from the date of issue.

ANNEXURE-A**GUIDELINES OF CHIEF MINISTER'S RELIEF FUND ARUNACHAL PRADESH**

1. In order to bring in more transparency in the distribution of financial assistance from CMRF for treatment purpose, payment of ex-gratia for victims of accident, death due to electrocution ; boat mishap; rape; riot death of security personnel in harness; victims of suspected militant/anti social elements, it has been decided to frame the following guidelines to streamline the system of financial assistance from Chief Minister's Relief Fund :

(A) Financial Assistace for Treatment.

1. Eligibility : 1. Distressed patients who are undergone treatment in Govt./Non-Govt. hospitals and are unable to bear the cost of treatment.
2. Patients who are not eligible to get reimbursement from employer / organization.
3. Patients who are not covered under Chief Minister's Universal Health Insurance Scheme.
4. Partients can avail the assistance only once for the same case in one financial year.

2. How to apply : People seeking financial assistance from CMRF may send their application in prescribed format along with all related documents to : The Secretary to Chief Minister, Government of Arunachal Pradesh, Itanagar.
- Following are the required documents :
- (i) All papers related to probable or actual expenditure for the treatment with certificate from the concerned authority. Cases more than three months prior to the date of receipt of application will not be admissible.
 - (ii) Recommendation from the elected representatives/Deputy Commissioners.
 - (iii) Certificate regarding availability/non-availability of financial assistance/reimbursement from the employer.
- Photo copies of all the documents are required to be attested by a Gazetted Officer.
3. Processing of the application : (a) The applications completed in all respects will be received in the CM's Secretariat.
(b) All the applications received in a month will be processed in the last week of that month.
(c) The applications will be checked with reference to its completeness in all respects and listed indicating all important fields and endorse to the Secretary/Commissioner to CM.
4. Quantum of assistance : The financial assistance from the fund will be to partially defray the expenses as a one-time grant in a financial year. The quantum of assistance may be recommended by a competent Officer or Board depending upon the nature of disease classified as critical and non-critical.
5. Sanctioning authority : On the recommendation as above, HCM will sanction the amount. HCM, may however, at his discretion may modify the quantum of assistance as recommended. Maximum financial assistance shall not exceed ₹ 4,00,000.
6. Disbursement of the assistance : Disbursement of the assistance will be done in the 2nd week of every month (subject to availability of fund) through SBI A/c Payee cheque only on proper receipt.
7. Cheque signing : HCM may authorise, Commissioner/Secretary to CM or any other authority/officer subordinate to them to sign the cheques upon prior sanction of the assistance by the competent authority.

(B) Ex-gratia for victims of accidents :

1. Henceforth no ex-gratia payment shall be done from the Home and District Administration Department.
2. All the cases of ex-gratia payment for death/injury caused due to road accident, suspected militant or anti-social attack, electrocution, boat mishap, riot victims, security personnel died in harness will be paid from CMRF instead of Home/DA departments.
3. Rate of ex-gratia :

1. Death per victim (to NoK)	—	₹ 4,00,000
2. Critically injured	—	₹ 2,00,000
3. Other injuries	—	₹ 50,000

Funding and Accounts

1. The Department of Disaster Management shall project annual requirement of fund for CMRF in the Budget Estimate.
2. The required fund shall be allocated to the Department of Disaster Management and in turn the Department shall draw the fund from Treasury and deposit into CMRF.
3. The Financial assistance received from the CSR Sector and other sources shall be properly accounted and fund shall be utilized judiciously.
4. The CM's Sectt shall handle the CMRF accounts as usual and disburse the ex-gratia and other financial assistance to the NoK/beneficiaries after proper verification and scrutiny of each case.
5. The NoK/beneficiaries should produce proper documents/identification documents for receiving the assistance.
