Thence from this point reference with GPS Coordinates 28°30'41.93" N ; 095° 09'38.31" E, marked as 'B' and bearing 152° an artificial line covering distance 900 mtr and reach point with GPS Coordinates 28°30'25.8" N ; 095° 09'47.16" E, marked as 'C'. From this point marked as 'C', with GPS coordinates 28°30'25.8" N ; 095° 09'47.16" E and bearing 143° an artificial line covering distance 650 mtr and reach point with GPS Coordinates 28°30'16.13" N ; 095° 09'00.0" E, marked as 'D'.

- North — Starting from a point on the left bank of Rapsa Ju near its source at geo-coordinates 26° 53' 14.291" N ; 95° 30' 24.937" E, the boundary goes northeastwards at bearing 62° for a distance of about 218 mtrs. upto the point at geo-coordinates 26° 53' 16.984" N ; 95° 30' 31.367" E, thence, at same bearing for about 293 mtrs upto the point at geo-coordinates 26° 53' 20.731" N ; 95° 30' 39.960" E, where it meets a rivulet of Longchak Ju. Thence, downstream along the rivulet upto its meeting point with another rivulet at geo-coordinates 26° 53' 21.473" N ; 95° 30' 53.694" E, thence, at bearing 64° passing through the point at geo-coordinates 26° 53' 25.444" N ; 95° 31' 2.039" E, and 26° 53' 27.161" N ; 95° 31' 5.646" E, upto the point 26° 53' 29.800" N ; 95° 31' 11.197" E.
