Pharma, B.Sc. (Agri/Horti/Forestry/Fishery/Nursing/MLT/RIT/OOT, etc.), GNM etc., shall be made on the basis of inter-se Merit of the eligible students of the State in the National Eligibility-Cum-Entrance Test (NEET) from the Academic session 2018-19.

The APJEE (PCB Degree) shall therefore stand discontinued with effect from 2018-19.

The prospective candidates for these courses should therefore invariably appear NEET from 2018-19 onwards to be eligible for selection in the various PCB group courses against the seats available with the State or allotted to the State.

Nomination of candidates for Medical related courses shall continue to be done by the Directorate of Medical Education, Research and Training and all other courses like viz. BV. Sc., B.Sc. (Agriculture, Horticulture, Fishery, Forestry etc.) by the Directorate of Higher and Technical Education on the basis of Merit List of NEET only.

The APJEE (Diploma) shall continue to be conducted annually.

Which is required to be complied within the state.

NOW THEREFORE, in compliance of the aforesaid notification and in view of the provision of Rule 108 [1 (ii) and 4] of Central Motor Vehicle Rule, 1989, the Governor of Arunahal Pradesh is pleased to order that no motor vehciles shall use red light on top of vehicle other than these specified in the Notification No. TPT (B) 22/04/2017 dated 30th January, 2018.

NOTIFICATION

No. TPT (B)22/04/2017.—In pursuance of power conferred under Rule 108 [1 (ii) and 4] of the Central Motor Vehicle Rule, 1989 read with Central Government notification No. G.S.R (E) dated 1st May, 2017 and No. S.O. 1374 (E) dated 1st May, 2017 and in supersession of all notifications issued earlier in this regards by the State Government, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to disallow the use of red light on top front side of vehicle. However, the vehicle on specified duties as provided hereunder are allowed to use multicolored red, green and white light on top front of the vehicle on duty specified as provided hereinafter :-

- (A) the duties relating to control of fire
- (B) the duties by police, defence forces or paramilitary forces for maintenance of law and orders.
- (C) the duties relating to management of natural disasters including earthquakes, flood, landslide, cyclone and manmade disasters including nuclear disaster, chemical disaster and biological disaster.

2. The multi-colored light shall not be put to use when the vehicle is not on the designated duty.

3. Every year Transport Department, Government of Arunachal Pradesh shall issue list of authorities to whom the permission to use the vehicles specified in clause (A) and (B) has been granted and such vehicles shall display on its windscreen the sticker issued by Transport Department which shall be in the following format, namely :-

“Government of Arunachal Pradesh

Designation of the Officer (s)

Vehicle No.”

- 4. Only one sticker shall be issued to designated officers for one vehicle at one point of time.
- 5. The sticker shall be on security printed water mark paper and shall carry hologram as specified by the Transport Department, Government of Arunachal Pradesh.

This Notification shall come into force with immediate effect.
