North : Starting from a point at geo-coordinates 27° 25' 42.552" N and 93° 2' 6.195" E, the boundary goes along straight line at bearing 105° for about 340 mtr., thence at bearing 74° for about 220 mtr, at bearing 95° for about 165 mtr., at bearing 73° for about 250 mtr. upto the point at geo-coordinates 27° 25' 44.265" N and 93° 2' 43.094" E.

East : Thence, the boundary goes southwards at bearing 157° for about 221 mtr., thence at bearing 147° for about 336 mtr., at bearing 172° for a distance of 440 mtr. upto the point at geo-coordinate 27° 25' 6.87" N and 93° 2' 55.789" E.

North : Starting from a point on the left bank of a branch Nallah locally known as Rallang Nallah of Poi Nallah at geo-coordinates 27° 24' 28.901" N and 93° 32' 40.337" E, the boundary goes eastwards at bearing of 82° for a distance of about 160 mtrs. upto the point 27° 24' 29.848" N and 93° 32' 46.932" E, thence, at a bearing 73° for about 196 mtrs. upto the point 27° 24' 32.159" N and 93° 32' 55.104" E, thence, at bearing 115° for about 334 mtrs. upto the point 27° 24' 28.656" N and 93° 33' 4.709" E, thence, north-eastwards passing through the geo-coordinates points 27° 24' 31.039" N and 93° 33' 6.217" E, 27° 24' 33.041" N and 93° 33' 6.754" E, 27° 24' 35.503" N and 93° 33' 5.861" E upto 27° 24' 38.032" N and 93° 33' 1.411" E on the Pila-Aurang foot path, thence, further, following the foot path northwards upto the point at geo-coordinates 27° 24' 52.747" N and 93° 33' 6.289" E on the bank of an unnamed feeder nallah of Pering Nallah.
