The Working Committee will prepare Diagnostic Guidelines.

Terms of Reference :

1. The Diagnostic Service Working Committee (Working Committee) shall ordinarily be held at state capital complex either at Naharlagun or Itanagar or at such place and on dates and time as may be decided by the Chairman of the Working Committee.

2. The aim of the Working Committee is to develop a Diagnostic Service Working guidelines, so that, the Health Care improves by proper diagnosis of the ailment of persons that pave ways for proper treatment of the ailing persons.

3. The Nodal Officer (Diagnostic Service), Deptt of Health, GoAP shall be convener of the ordinary meeting. The convener shall coordinate/laisse different diagnostic specialists/Lab Specialists and clinicians to evolve working guidelines for Diagnostic Service in State of Arunachal Pradesh.

4. The Working Committee shall meet within first month of notification of the said committee and work out common working guidelines.

5. The sitting shall be convened by convener of Working Committee and 'Working Guidelines' shall be published within first 6 month, from the date of first sitting. Subsequent sitting may be convened till 'Working Guidelines' is not evolved and approved by Govt thereof.

6. The agenda shall be provided by the Convener, that, different diagnostic specialists shall work in their line of specialization. The grey zone shall be discussed and evolve common consensus working points.

7. In case of meeting is being convened, but Chairman is absent due to pre-occupation of or on official leave or personal/domestic problem such as on medical ground, the Chairman or APMC shall act as Chairman of Working Committee, without postponing the schedule of meeting.

8. The Working Committee shall review the Diagnostic Service Working Guidelines, if any, queries/questions/litigation arises before approval by state Govt.

9. Every meeting shall be presided over by the Chairman of the Working Committee. However, in his absence, the Chairman of APMC shall act as Chairman of Diagnostic Service Working Committee.

10. In absence of any member of the Working Committee at the time of the scheduled meeting, the meeting shall be represented by the representative/s of the Diagnostic Specialty appointed/invited by the convener.

11. The Working Committee shall submit its final 'Working Guidelines' to the head of the department for Govt. approval. The Diagnostic Service guidelines shall be followed in the state to streamline the Diagnostic services whether public or private set up of health care centres.

12. The minutes of meeting shall be drafted by the Convener of the meeting ordinarily. In Case of special meeting, the minutes of the meeting shall be drafted by Chairman of the meeting.

13. The minutes of every meeting shall be approved by the Chairman of the Working Committee for circulation.

14. The expenditure of ordinary meeting shall be borne by the 'Diagnostic Service Division', Directorate of Health Services, Naharlagun, Govt of Arunachal Pradesh.

Subject : Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Swavalamban Yojana

No. PD(SPD)-29/DDUSY/2017-18/296. — The Government of Arunachal Pradesh has decided to continue the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Swavalamban Yojana to encourage unemployed youth and entrepreneurship and to gain access to low cost capital for entrepreneurship.

- (a) Under this scheme, a provision of 40% back ended capital investment subsidy to the beneficiaries has been made who wish to set up small and medium enterprises with a loan from ₹ 10.00 lakhs upto ₹ 50 .00 lakhs excluding the cost of land and building.
 - (b) The loan component would be 30% of the project cost.
 - (c) Entrepreneurs would be required to contribute at least 30% of project cost as their contribution. Preference will be given to those who contribute a greater proportion.
 - (d) Women entrepreneurs will be additionally eligible for 5% interest subsidy annually provided the entrepreneur does not become Non-Performing Asset (NPA).
 - (e) Entrepreneurs will be required to be registered under Start Up India Scheme.
2. The sectors covered under this scheme are:-
- (a) Food-processing units in agriculture, horticulture and allied sectors including packaging, cold chain, cold storage, milk and food processing etc.
 - (b) Eco-tourism including home stays and tour operators.
 - (c) Traditional textile weaving for modernisation of traditional looms and purchase of new looms to start a new weaving unit.
 - (d) Small scale manufacturing units /service centres/ diagnostic centres to be set up by qualified graduates/ Diploma holders.

(Preference to be given to those unemployed youths having Degree/Diploma holders in Tourism & Hospitality, ITI or any other technical degree/diploma related to Fabrication, IT, Mobile repairing, Motor Garage etc. Preference will also be given to private doctors for opening of medical clinic and diagnostic centers in the Border CD blocks. However, the clinical fees shall be fixed at a reasonable rate).

3. A District Level Screening Committee would screen the loan applications.

The District level Screening Committee shall comprise of the following:-

(a) Deputy Commissioner	-	Chairman

(d) District Agricultural Officer	-	Member
(e) District Horticulture Officer	-	Member
(f) District Fishery Officer	-	Member

(j) District Planning Officer	-	Member-Secretary

4. The District Planning Officer (DPO) will function as Entrepreneurship Development Officer. The prospective entrepreneurs should submit their applications in prescribed format as at **Annexure 'A'** along with the educational qualifications and make a presentation before the District Level Screening Committee which would meet at least once a month.
5. Based on the budgetary provision, Planning & Investment Division of Finance, Planning & Investment Department will convey district-wise yearly target to the Deputy Commissioners. The State Government will reserve the right to review the targets, if necessary.
6. While submitting the project proposals at the District level, the candidate will have to submit a concept note in the standard format. The screening committee will first scrutinize the proposals by involving Bank Managers. The short listed candidates will have to make PPT presentation before the District committee before it is forwarded to the State Government. The concerned bank managers should satisfy themselves that the project proposal is bankable and also ensure that all relevant documents for loan are enclosed with the application.
7. The commitment by the State Govt. will be only in the form of a guarantee to release back ended subsidy by the State Government subject to the condition that any Scheduled Bank should be authorized to advance loan against the project of the applicant and the onus of availing the loan from the scheduled bank will be entirely and entirely the responsibility of applicant.
8. Thereafter, the bank will consider the application of the candidate for loan. Once the loan is approved, the same will be conveyed by the Bank to the Planning & Investment Division through Lead Bank Manager. The State Government will release the subsidy to the bank in instalment commensurate with the progress of the scheme, A mutually agreed amount may be placed with the bank in advance which will act as buffer for this purpose. To this effect Planning & Investment Division will take necessary steps for obtaining A/A and E/S from the competent authorities and transfer subsidy amount to the bank.
9. The Banks will further release subsidy to the applicant with due approval of Deputy Commissioner concerned only after a joint field inspection by the District Planning Officer and the concerned Branch Manager and submission of a report by them to the Deputy Commissioner recommending release of subsidy amount.
10. The recommendation of District Level Screening Committee will be considered final and there will be no request to Finance, Planning & Investment Department for any review. Since, there is a loan component in the scheme which has to be decided by Banks depending on the bankability of the project, any request for review may be re-submitted to the District Committee only for appropriate decision.
11. DDUSY can be dovetailed with Mudra Yojana and Banks may kindly honor such a convergence.



