Subject :- Grant of Dearness Allowances - Revised rates effective from 1st January, 2018.

No. FIN/E-II/07/97 (Pt)/35.—In pursuance to the Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure' OM No. 1/1/2018-E-II (B) dated 15th March, 2018 on the subject mentioned above, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to order that the Dearness Allowance (DA) payable to State Government Employees shall be enhanced from the existing rate of **5% to 7%** of basic pay with effect from **1st January, 2018.**

2. The DA arrears w.e.f. 1st January, 2018 shall be credited in the bank accounts of all Government employees in the revised pay structure of 7th Pay Commission.

3. The expenditure on account of this Dearness Allowance will be met from existing Budget provisions of the Department concerned in the Current Financial year 2018-19.

4. The revised rates of Dearness Allowance will be applicable to regular State Government employees only and will not apply to private/Non-Governmental institutions receiving grants-in-aids from the State Government.
