CITIZENS' CHARTER

This Charter is a declaration of our commitment to achieve excellence in formulation and implementation of Policies and Procedures of the Department of Legal Metrology & Consumer Affairs for the benefit of the consumers and the public at large.

Our Motto :

1. Maintenance of accuracy in weights, measures, weighing & measuring.
2. Safety of consumer products and protection of Consumer's rights & interests.

Our Responsibilities :

1. To administer the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and Rules framed thereunder for the regulation or weights and measures, weighing and measuring instruments in the State.
2. To administer the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 under which a 3-tier structure of consumer redressal agencies at the district, state and national level has been set up to provide speedy and inexpensive relief to the consumer with genuine grievances.
3. To operate the State Consumer Welfare fund that provides financial assistance for promoting and protecting welfare of consumers, generate consumers' awareness and strengthen the consumer movement in the State.
4. We are the Nodal Department for monitoring & co-ordinating activities of the Bureau of Indian Standards which is a statutory body, responsible for formulation of need- based Indian Standards, certification of goods (i.e. grant of licence for use of ISI Mark, quality system certification, laboratory testing etc.).

Our Commitment :

1. To ensure regulation of weights & measures and accuracy in all transactions including commercial, public health and consumers' safety.
2. To deal with all applications for financial assistance from the Consumer Welfare Fund within the time-frame set out in Annexure-I.
3. To deal with all applications received under the provisions of the Legal Metrology Act and Rules made thereunder within the time frame set out in Annexure-II.

4. To give prompt attention to public grievances and dispose them off within the time frame set out in Annexure-III.
5. To take all possible steps, including amendment of the Consumer Protection Act 1986 and Rules made thereunder wherever required to facilitate the speedy disposal of cases filed in the consumer redressal agencies.
6. To establish the advisory bodies, namely, State Consumer Protection Council (SCPC) and District Consumer Protection Councils (DCPC) under the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 to promote and protect the rights of the consumers and hold regular meetings thereof.

Our Expectation :

- We expect formation of more Voluntary Consumer Organisations to raise Voice of common consumers in the appropriate Forums.
- We expect Consumers to come forward with their grievances to the appropriate forum to help us to safeguard their rights & interests.
- We expect the applicants/recipients of grant to file their applications with all necessary information to enable expeditious processing of their requests.
- We expect recipients of grants from the Consumer Welfare Fund to submit the required progress reports, utilization certificates etc., as prescribed and send audited statements of expenditure as prescribed in the terms and conditions of the grant.

Annexure-I

Time Frame for Disposal of Applications for Assistance under the Consumer Welfare Fund (CWF).

- Applicant to be intimated within 30 (thirty) working days of receipt of application, if the eligibility criteria are not met or application is incomplete.
- Decision on final selection of eligible applicants to be taken and intimated within 12 (twelve)weeks from the date of receipt of recommendations of the State Government where called for.

Release of Grant :

- Grant will be released after issue of sanction in cases approved by the Standing Committee on CWF within 60 days after the applicant complies with all the pre- release requirements of the sanction subject to clearance of the State Finance Department.

Statement of Accounts :

- Accounts will be settled within 60 days after the submission of audited statement of expenditure and meeting other requirements prescribed in the terms and conditions of the grant.

Annexure-II**Time Frame for dealing with application under the Legal Metrology Acts & Rules :**

1. (a) Verification of Weights & Measures. : 5 (five) days
- (b) Verification of weights & Measures outside office : 10 (ten) days
2. Issue of Dealership Licence : 90 (ninety) days.
3. Issue of Repairers Licence. : 90 (ninety) days.
4. (a) Registration of packer under provision of Legal Metrology (packer commodities) Rule, 2011 : Within 90 days from the date of receipt of complete application
- (b) Return of incomplete Application Forms for removal of deficiencies. : Within 60 (sixty) days from the date of receipt.

Annexure-III**Time Frame for Disposal if Public Grievances****Acknowledgement :**

- Referring the grievance to the concerned Organisation (if it does not directly concerned the Department) under intimation to the petitioner. : Within 30 (thirty) days.
- Final disposal of the petition if it directly concerns the Department and informing the petitioner of the outcome, failing whom to inform the petitioner about the reasons for delay. : Within 3(three) months.
