No. MED/NS/2/2018.—According to Indian Nursing Council, the services of ANM is local specific and their services is used for local people at village level to overcome cultural, ritual and language barrier, for easy excess of Health care services at grass root level.

Further, on account of frequent transfer-posting of ANM from on place to another, hampering the smooth functioning of health centres in the State, the following rules are hereby notified to govern the services conditions of the ANM with immediate effect.

1. ANM services shall be restricted to preventive and promotive services only. No ANM shall be utilized in curative services at Hospital level.
2. Their services shall be utilized in Labour Room, ANC, PNC, Immunization at PHC, CHC & Hospital level.
3. All ANM have to submit monthly performance report to respective DMO/DRCHO which shall include, total no. of village, monthly birth-death, total population age-wise, total house hold, total pregnant women, total women under ANM, total eligible couple, total lactating mother, total adolescent, children under 5 years, status of immunization, sanitary and hygiene's status under her jurisdiction in proper format.
4. They shall maintain family cards of all household under her jurisdiction which shall include; family identity card, ANC Card, PNC Card, immunization card lactating mother cards. Elderly person/age 60 and above card, Non-communicable disease card, etc.
5. The Job responsibility not specified here shall be govern by the Govt. Rules circulated from time to time in accordance with Public Health Services Rules/Guidelines.

6. The post creation/appointment ANM shall be District/Sub-Centre specific.
 7. The services of ANM shall not be transferable from District to District. But they shall be rotate within District for smooth functioning of the Health Centres.
 8. No ANMs shall be transfer from one District to other after publication of this in official Gazette.
 9. Transfer on mutual exchange only shall be considered.

TERMINATION ORDER

The 12th September, 2018

No. TAX(E-277/2009(Pt-1). — WHEREAS, vide Judgement and Order dated 22nd December, 2009 of Ld. Single Bench of the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, Itanagar Permanent Bench in WP (C) 86 (AP) 2009, the initial appointment on officiating basis and the subsequent regularization order dated 26th November, 2007 in respect of 4 (four) Assistant Inspectors (Tax & Excise) namely Shri Decem Pangkam, Shri Tuong Sena, Shri Sonai Bellai and Shri Obang Pangkam were quashed and set aside on the basis of illegal one-time relaxation granted by the Government ;

2. AND WHEREAS, the Hon'ble High Court further directed that the aforesaid 4 (four) posts of Assistant Inspector be filled up by initiating regular recruitment process as required under relevant Recruitment Rules and the entire process be completed within a period of 4 (four) months with effect from 4th January 2010 and till such time the regular appointment are made, the 4 (four) appointees **may** be allowed to continue in service ;

3. AND WHEREAS, an Appeal was preferred against the above Order dated 22nd December, 2009 before a Double Bench of Hon'ble Gauhati High Court by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh vide Case No. WA.315/2011, and the Hon'ble Court dismissed the Appeal on merit vide Order dated 24th January, 2012. Further, another Appeal in the Double Bench of Hon'ble Gauhati High Court (WA No. 12 (AP)/2010) preferred by the four Assistant Inspectors (Tax & Excise) met the same fate ;

4. AND WHEREAS, a Special Leave Appeal (Civil) vide No. 13309/2012 was filed against the Judgement and Order of the Learned Double Bench in WA No. 315/2011 dated 24th January, 2012 by the Department before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, but the same was dismissed by the Hon'ble Court on 4th May, 2012. Accordingly, the Judgement and Order dated 22nd December, 2009 passed by the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, Itanagar Permanent Bench (Single Bench) became final ;

5. AND WHEREAS, it has been found that the four illegal appointees are still continuing in the service and enjoying all the benefits since the Department has not been able to complete the entire process of recruitment even after almost nine years since the order of Hon'ble High Court ;

6. AND WHEREAS, it has been observed that the linkage of termination of their services to the completion of the regular appointment was not mandatory ; and in any case, their service was not to continue beyond four months from 4th January, 2014 as per Order of the Hon'ble Court ;

7. NOW, therefore, the Government of Arunachal Pradesh has decided to terminate the services of the following four illegal appointees **with immediate effect** :-

1. Shri Decem Pangkam, Assistant Inspector (Tax & Excise).
2. Shri Toung Sena, Assistant Inspector (Tax & Excise).
3. Shri Sonai Bellai, Assistant Inspector (Tax & Excise).
4. Shri Obang Pangkam, Assistant Inspector (Tax & Excise).

8. Accordingly, the services of the above named four Assistant Inspectors of Tax & Excise Department are ordered to be terminated with immediate effect. Further, their names shall be deleted from the Seniority List of Assistant Inspector (Tax & Excise) and from other official records forthwith .

Subject : Implementation of Leave provision under the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013-regarding.

No. 13026/2/2016-Estt(L). — Consequent to the enactment of the ‘Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013’, this Department is considering issuing instructions for the grant of leave to the aggrieved woman during pendency of inquiry up to a period of three months in addition to the leave which she is otherwise entitled to.

2. In this regard, it is proposed to insert/incorporate a new Rule in the CCS (Leave) Rules, 1972. The new rule may read as follows :

“Special Leave connected with inquiry on sexual harassment - Leave up to a maximum of 90 days may be granted to an aggrieved female Government Servant on the recommendation of the Internal Committee or the Local Committee, as the case may be, during the pendency of inquiry under Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013.

(2) *The leave so granted to the aggrieved woman under this rule shall not be debited against the leave account”.*
